Carolina and County of Chatham being sick in body but of sound
and perfect mind and memory, or you may say then, Considering the
uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound and perfect mind and memory
God for the same, do make and publish this my last Will & Testament
in Manner and form following that to wit say First I give and bequeath
unto my beloved wife Peter Brewer the sum of all the furniture
belonging to the House and also one cow and also the growing wheat
and also six months provision I do give and bequeath unto her to
be to the use of her and any child or my Children, and the Remainder
of the property to be sold, and all just debts paid and the Remainder of
the Money if any I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Peter
Brewer the sum of Ten dollars. And I do give unto my Child or Children
all sum of money remaining to the use of my Child or Children to
be on Interest until he or they are twenty one Year of age equally
to be divided between them and lastly as to all the Rest Residue and
Remainder of my property what kind and Nature soever to be sold and
divided Equally between my Child or Children Peter Brewer

the following to be my last Will and Testament.

I nominate and appoint Capt. John Bruce and Charles P. Jones of
the Town of Fayetteville my Executors — I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Maria Louisa Ramsey my watch chain and Purse and
two silver Tea Spoons

I give and bequeath to my son Albert Gallatin Ramsey his silver
Tea Spoon my silver Sugar Tong

I give and bequeath to my son John Calhoun Ramsey his
large silver Spoon. — My Will is that all my Bed & table Linen
Bedstead given to me by Capt. Bruce be equally divided amongst
my three Children above named — I give and bequeath to my

Daughter Maria Bruce my Bell metal Shells, and my sister Caroline
Jones my Brass Mirror & fiddle and my children, crib and the
Bed belonging to it — And my Will is that all the remainder
of my personal estate (except my Negroes sold by my Executors
and the proceeds together with such debts as are owing to me be
applied to the payment of my debts

My Will is that my Executors sell the plantation & land
