last Will and Testament In manner as following

#1 I lend to my loving wife Wincy Wilson during her life time or
widowhood one third part of all my lands including my houses and
plantation where now live one negro woman by the name of
Ellen one negro man by the name of Parrett and one negro boy
by the name of Bob one horse bridle and saddle two cows and calves
one feather bed and furniture on chest and all my kitchen furniture
and one year provision and one negro boy by the name of Ranson

#2 I give to my son James Wilson out of the property left to my wife
at her death or widowhood one hundred and Twenty five dollars
to him and his heirs for ever

#3 I give to my son ~~James~~ William Wilson after the death of my wife
or widowhood one hundred and Twenty five dollars to be
paid out of the property I have left to my wife to him and his heirs
for ever

#4 I give to my loving Daughter Lucy Charance and her body
heirs one negro girl by the name of Melinda to her and her heirs
for ever

#5 I give to my loving Daughter Nancy Goodwin and her body
heirs one negro girl by the name of Lisa to her and her heirs for
ever

#6 I give to my loving daughter Wincy Wilson one negro girl by the
name of Juliana to her and her heirs for ever

#7 I give to my loving son Stephen Wilson & his heirs to him and
his heirs for ever

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It is my wish and desire that at the death or widow hood of my
loving wife Nancy Wilson that after paying to my son James
Wilson and my son Wm Wilson the one hundred and twenty
five dollars each then the balance to be equally divided between
James Wilson William Wilson Henderson Wilson Allen
Willson Lucy ~~Baran~~ Nancy Goodwin Nancy Wilson to
them and their heirs for ever

I hereby appoint my loving sons Henderson Wilson and
Allen Wilson my Executors to this my last and only Will
and Testament.
