


hold furniture tools of every sort to my daughters then  
living to be equally divided among them - and if they  
many of I wish my wife to give them such things as she  
thinks right so as not to give more than one share  
my shot gun I give to James my youngest son if ~~him~~  
or James should die before James becomes of age the other  
is to have Sep - Lettis to work with my wife Martha  
Dodd during her life time or widowhood and then she  
is to go to my daughters then living. Thirdly I wish for my  
debts to be paid out of my crop and if not enough  
some of the stock must be sold with the crop to make  
enough. Fourthly and lastly I do appoint my wife  
Martha Dodd and my son William Executors to  
this my last will and Testament in witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my  
seal this 1<sup>st</sup> of May 1835 - James Dodd

In the name of God Amen I Thomas  
Hinshaw of Chatham County and State  
of North Carolina being weak and low in  
health though in perfect sense and memory  
calling to mind that all men must die do  
make this my last will and Testament  
first I give my soul to God who gave it

And now concerning my worldly Estate the land that  
I now live on being all that I own I give and  
leave it to be divided as follows to my son —  
Thomas the south end of my land Beginning  
at a Black Jack my old corner and running  
south twenty five poles to a Stake then east across  
my land to Macon Murason's line him the  
said Thomas to have all my land south of the  
said line the balance of my land i give and  
leave to my wife Nancy to have and to hold in  
full possession during her life then to fall to my  
son Thomas now i desire my just debts and  
funeral charges to be paid I also give my son  
an chest and large peacock dish one pot and  
furniture my wife to have the care and use  
of them until the child is fifteen years of age  
my wife to have all the rest of the house hold  
and Kitchen furniture also one loom one  
cow and Calf one stand of Bed one sow and pigs  
Three Sheep the rest of my Estate if there  
be any to be equally divided between my  
wife and Child and in this my last will  
I appoint Samson Edwards my Executor  
and request him to discharge his faithful  
duty December 7th 1835 — Thos Hinshaw
