 In the name of God amen I Thomas Lambeth of the County
 and state aforesaid being of sound disposing mind and
 thanks be to God for his inestimable blessings and considering the
 uncertainty of this mortal life that it is appointed for all men
 to die do make and publish this my last will and Testament
 in manner and form as follows viz 1st I recommend my
 soul to God who gave it and that my body be decently buried at
 the option of my family 2^d My Will is that all my just debts be
 paid and I do give that the following distribution of my Estate be
 3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary all my money
 and title in the tract of land wherein she formerly lived in
 Orange County estimated at Five Hundred acres be it the
 same more or less and all my stock of cattle and hogs on the
 said plantation one horse her choice out of all my
 money five and twenty one choice bed and furniture and
 my house hold and kitchen furniture at the said plantation
 and four negroes viz Ned community called Little Ned
 about forty years of age Fanny a woman about thirty years
 of age (distinguished as black Fanny) and her two children
 Jack a boy about ten years old and Sam a boy about seven
 years old. The still at the said plantation excepted.
 4th I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Mitchell and
 heirs of her body (her children) the Tract of land wherein
 now resides lying immediately on the river upon the east side
 joining Mrs. Vandorant and others estimated at about one
 hundred and thirty acres be it the same more or less to be
 received with two hundred and fifty dollars and all the
 residue of my Estate both real and personal to be sold by my
 Executors not sooner than four months after my demise to the
 highest bidder on the premises on such credit as my Executors
 may think proper not exceeding one year and all the money
 of sale and debts due to be equally divided amongst my three
 children and the lawful children of my deceased children
 allowing allowing to my deceased son Alfred children
 what would have been his part if alive as an equal share
 and to the children of my deceased daughter Catharine

what would have been her part if alive as an equal share
 and the price of the land bequeathed to my daughter Mary
 be held and her children to be reckoned as that amount to her
 out of her equal part of my estate and the balance of her part to
 descend to her children at her decease
 Lastly I nominate and appoint my son Thomas and my son in law
 Pompey Johnson as Executors to this my last Will & Testament hereby
 annulling, revoking and making Void all Wills by me heretofore
 made Published and declared as this my last Will Testament
 under my hand and seal this 8th day of March AD 1836

 The foregoing last will and Testament of Thomas Lambeth deceased
 was duly exhibited in open court and proved by the Oath of
 J W Pym and A B Keen the subscribing Witnesses thereto and read to
 be recorded whereupon Thomas Lambeth his son & Pompey Johnson
 Executors therein named appeared in open court and was duly
