beloved wife her life time, after her death whatever property then

Watling my daughter Rachel Right her part, to be equally divided  
among her Children Elizabeth Elmore, Rebecca Wilson, Jesse  
Stone, Sarah Stone, Elijah Stone, Asa Stone, Theb. Piggan  
Anna Stone, Joseph F. Stone. I also constitute make and  
ordain John Piggan and Joseph F. Stone the sole Executors of  
this my last Will and Testament whereunto I do set my hand  
this 31<sup>st</sup> day of August in the  
Year of our Lord and Saviors Jesus Christ Anno Domini  
Eighteen hundred and twenty six
