 near the middle of the first sheet, and she was any
 issue of her body living at my daughters death
 in the last line of the said first sheet, being first
 interlined in the presence of us who at her request then
 subscribed our names as witnesses hereto, & the words any such
 issue being first struck & the words any issue of her body
 being set instead thereof before the execution of this Will.

 of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina being
 of sound and perfect mind and memory (Alleged to be) on
 the tenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and seven made and published this my
 last Will and Testament in manner and form following
 viz. I do give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Jones

in addition to the Land I have before given him.
 a Negro Man named Sep to him and his heirs forever
 previously delivered unto my said son Thomas.

2^d I give and bequeath unto my son Edward Wiers
 in addition to the Land I have before given him, one
 Negro Man named Pompey to him and his heirs.

forever previously delivered unto my said son Edward.

3^d I give and bequeath unto my son John Wiers
 in addition to the Land before given him one Negro
 Man named Isaac to him and his heirs forever

previously delivered unto my said son John Wiers.

4th I give and bequeath unto my son Newb Wiers
 one Negro Man named Anthony, all that tract
 of Land whereon I now live known by the name

of the Parake with all the other Lands belonging
 to me adjoining said tract, one good Plow
 one good Horse four head

of Cattle with other furniture necessary for a new begin-
 as to housekeeping, and working tools sufficient for his plan-
 tation use unto my said son Wiers his heirs and
 one apiece forever. 5th I give and bequeath unto my

Daughter Martha Wiers two Negro women that is
 Frank and Clarissa, also one Negro girl Sarah

and two Negro Children, one named Lewis and the
 other Dilly and their increase unto my said daughter

her heirs and apiece forever. 7th I give and bequeath unto
 my daughter Rebecca a Negro Man called Henry a Negro

girl called Betty and a Negro boy named Osborne and
 their increase unto my said daughter Rebecca her heirs

and apiece forever. 8th I give and bequeath unto my

son Edward William Wiers Johanna Wiers fifty

fifty dollars to be divided equally between them, having
 given each of them their portion of property at the time

of my residence in Virginia.

9th I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
 Mary Wiers daughter of my son Thomas Wiers, one

Negro girl called Liza, and her increase unto my said

Grand Daughter and her heirs forever.

10th I leave unto my wife Mary nine Negroes that is
 two yellow young Phil and the Phil and three boys

Calby, James & John, also two Negro Women, Susa and

Hannah & Hannah's two Daughters Betty and Susa

and at my said wife's decease I will that the nine

Negroes should be equally divided among her children to

have and to hold them and their heirs forever. I also

My wife should have the use of the Land and plantation
 or as much thereof as is necessary for her support comfort
 & family during life and after that to be immediately be paid
 by my son Richard as ~~before~~ mentioned. Further I give
 and bequeath unto my present wife's Children, Lucia negro
 that is Old Ned Young & Ned, Peter, John, Stephen, Peter &
 a Negro Wench Clark with her increase & also I will
 that all my remaining Stock, Furniture, Money &c. shall
 be equally divided after paying all my just debts among
 my present wife's Children to have to hold to them and
 their heirs forever & I do hereby make and ordain my
 four sons Thomas, Edward, John and Newton, Heirs and
 also my three sons in law James McMath Robert Milner
 and Abraham Serice executors of this my last Will &
 Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & Seal the day & year before written.

and bind themselves that they will firmly to abide by
the contents of my last Will and Testament in full - and
they do hereby agree if they should ever intentionally
of their estate from the same that they understand that
their property contained in the Will shall devolve
unto the other by a true intention to remain firm by and
substantially theirs as by the Will. In witness whereof

June 1807.
