I Thomas Vital of Chatham County and State of North
 Carolina, being Sane and of full age and memory, late
 knowing that it is appointed for all men to die, I do
 make this my last Will and Testament. Touching such
 worldly estate and half pence, God be bless me with
 I give devise and dispose of the same in following
 form. I ordain, constitute and appoint my truly
 friends William Vital and William Toarshall
 to be my only and sole executors of this my last
 Will and Testament, allowing my last debts & funeral
 charges to be first paid out of my estate. First, I
 give unto Elizabeth my dear Wife, one fine ch^{er}
 one feather Bed & Furniture 2 Pair Dishes 2 Pair
 Barren, half dozen Plate plates, two Cols, one oven
 one Spinning Wheel, one Iron pan one Stove
 Sack of Beans, two Cows & Cattle two Sheep, Hogs
 and fifty pounds in money to be her own.

And likewise I give her that part of the plantation
we live on with House and Orchard during her life time
or widowhood. And I give her the privilege of the house
hold Furniture while a widow. And the Land I now live on
I leave between David and Elias Vestal that is to have Elias
from forty Rod from her North East corner. North. Then
that fifty Rod Road then North to divide line, and to have
all the bottom ^{line of my property} on the East, from one dividing line to the
other, to him and His heirs. And the rest of the said land
I give to David my son, to him and his heirs forever.
And the rest of my estate I leave to be equally divided
among my ten Children or to their heirs if dead
and I leave my care to be divided among my sons and
William is to have the big Bible and the House. I require
that my Executors of this my last Will and Testament
to act in place or in my stead as Trustees of the whole
charge. And I require them to discharge this Trust
faithfully. In witness and testimony whereof I have
set my hand and placed my seal this 22nd day of the 7th
Month 1807.
