do make and ordain this my last will and Testament
first recommending my soul to Almighty God who gave
it and my body to be decently buried at the discretion
of my Executor hoping ^{through} the Merits of Christ for a blessed
Resurrection and as touching the worldly estate which
God hath given me - First I lend the use and profit
of all my Lands and plantation with all my house-
hold and Kitchen with my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep
hog and Goats and one Negro woman named Jenny
to my beloved wife Esther Wicker during her natural
life and after her decease to be disposed of as follows
Viz I Give and bequeath to my son James Wicker
all my Lands and plantation wheron I now live
with three Negroes and their increase named Becky
Mary and Nelson with one Cow and Calf which
Cattle he shall have at the death of his Mother -
I Give to my daughter Elizabeth Gunter three Negroes
with their increase named Nancy, Lucy & Fanny -
I Give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Polly
Sullivan and to the lawful heirs of her body one
Negro Girl named Jenny with her increase -
I Give to my Son Robert Wicker three Negroes with
their increase named Phillis, Brad and Dolly -
I Give to my Son Matthew Wicker two Negroes with
their increase named Charles and Franky -
I Give to my Grandson Lewis Gunter one Negro wo-
man named Jenny -
I Give the children of my Son David Wicker one
Negro woman named Hannah with her in -

crease to be divided among said children whose
names are Coleman James and Rebecca -
I give to my son Thomas Wicker one Negro Girl with
her increase named Sarah -
It is my will and desire that after the death of
my wife Esther Wicker that all the household and
kitchen furniture ^{left to her} shall go to my son James Wicker
I do hereby Appoint my trusty friend Richard Drake
my Executor of this my last Will and Testament
overuling all other Wills made by me heretofore
Given under My hand this three day of January
in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and Twenty Four -
