one Feather bed with stand and furniture, that is generally
Cold mine by the family also one Cow and calf one
and Cypress three Cows and Lands, as a for husbandry
provision. I Give her Four Hundred Pounds of Pork
barns corn Five pounds Coffee and Fifteen Pounds Sugar
also Six head of geese
Item 3rd I Give to my wife Abby Hatley during her life
time or till she dies one third of the land of land that
I now live on including my dwelling house
Item 4th it is my Will and desire that all my negroes
be sold with all and every part of my private property
that I have not here before Will say
Item 5th I Give and bequeath unto my son sons namely
William, Stanford, Uriah, Gideon, Jackson and
all Hatley, the land of land which I now live to be
Equally divided amongst them by lot or sale thereof
when they are full I shall come to of age

19. Item 6th I Give and bequeath unto my three daughters
namely Rebecca Pilkington, Humphreys Pilkington and
Milly Hatley all the residue of my Estate that I have not
here before Will say
Item 7th and lastly I do hereby nominate appoint and Ordain
my trusty friends William Hatley and Thomas Bell or
either of them my Executors Executor to this my last
Will and Testament making all other wills by me made
and acknowledged this and this only to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form as above
