Then I bind unto my beloved son John

Then I lend unto my beloved wife Ann all
the negro slave that I own at my death during
her natural life and at her death I will and
bequeath the same to all of my children to be
equally divided amongst them slave & share
able to have and to hold to them their heirs
assigns forever

I then lived unto my beloved wife Ann during her natural life all the avails of my estate of every description. I then I have put into the possession of my

I have put in the possession of every description. I then immediately transfer a negro girl by the name of Thos which I am willing for him to keep about account for upon a final settlement of my estate.

Item I have put in the possession of my son ³⁶ ~~Wm~~ ^{Wm} Williams a negro girl by the name of Patsy which I am willing for him to keep and account for him as a final settlement of my estate. Then As my children marry off or become of age my will is that they receive from my estate as much in value as I have advanced any of my married children. Then It is my will that the sum of forty five dollars be expended on my three youngest children in schooling and if that sum is not thought sufficient by my executors they can expend more.

I then It is my will that upon a final settlement
 of my Estate all of my children shall receive a
 Schedule of The advancements made to them by me in
 my life time, And I do hereby constitute and
 appoint my then sons Robert J. Foshier Wm. Foshier
 George W. Foshier and my trusty friend A. A. Stearns
 my lawful Executors to ~~do~~ ~~execute~~ ~~the~~ purpo
 ses to execute this my last will and Testament acc
 ording to The true intent and meaning of The same
 and every part & every clause thereof hereby avowing and
 declaring null & void all other wills & Testaments
 by me ~~made~~ ~~made~~ made In witness whereof I the

 seal 31st day of March A.D. 1849
