

In the name of God Amen I William Lassiter of the State of North Carolina County of Chatham bearing that it is my mind for all men to see to do make this my last will and Testament in manner following (viz)

Item 1<sup>st</sup> That all my just debts and funeral Expenses be discharged by my Executors as soon as practicable

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> That my Executors advance to my daughter Elizabeth Drake Three Hundred Dollars as soon as convenient to assist in the support of herself and family & further I lend the said Elizabeth the use of the tract of land I purchased of Gordon Holleman one bed and furniture and the articles which I purchased at George Drakes sale now in her possession during her life and at her death to be equally divided between her children-

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give & bequeath to my son Bernut Lassiter one Negro man slave by the name of young Tom one desk & Book case one bed and furniture and one cow & calf to him & his heirs forever-

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I lend to my daughter Susannah Meiners one Negro Boy by the name of Louely during her life to assist in the maintenance of herself & family and at her death or sooner if she may think proper to descend to her issue the heirs of her body if there should be such & in case there should be no issue then to the common stock to be disposed of as hereafter directed

Item 5<sup>th</sup> And as regards my beloved wife Rebecca Lassiter the residue of my Estate I lend to her during her life or as much thereof as she may think proper to retain in her possession to be used by her for her maintenance & support, with the exception of the money on hand and debts due which is to remain in the hands of my Executors to defray charges support my wife if it should appear most advisable support disburse and own out slaves if any To assist any unfortunate brother or sister if such a case should occur by the visitation of God and render them an object of charity -

Item 6<sup>th</sup> At the death of my wife or at any time when any part or the whole of the property and especially well away shall come into the hands of my Executors that they proceed to an equal division of the same between all my children that are now living or their lawful heirs my will is that my Executors while acting honest incur no liability and if any thing should appear ambiguous or doubtful of meaning the point aimed at is an equal division of the property in my possession at my death between all and every one of my children that are now living & I further constitute and appoint my three sons Tho: John & Bernut Lassiter my Executors to this my
