In the name of God I now William Haman
of the County of Chatham being weak of body but of sound
mind and disposing money do make this my last Will
and Testament in manner and form as follows to witness
that it is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid
together with my funeral expenses paid and for the purpose
of better enabling my Executors herein after named paying
the same I hereby Will that they sell either at publick or
publick sale the tract of land wherow I formerly lived
it being the land I purchased of my Brother Thos. W. adjoin-
ing lands of W^m. Great and others - 2^d I tend unto my
beloved wife Mary all the rest of my estate both real and
personal including the place where I live, all my negroes
all my Stock Household and Kitchen furniture during her
natural life or widowhood. 3^d Having beamed all my
property except one tract of land which is directed to be
sold, to my beloved wife Mary during her natural life
or widowhood, my great object is to enable her rear my
dear little Children. 4^d I will and desire that as my children
become of age or marry that my Executors give to them

such part of my Estate as in their discretion can
be spent so as not to interfere with the raising of the
children or injure the comfortable situation of my wife.

4. I will that after the death of my wife that all my pro-
perty of every description be equally divided between all my
children than and then alike to them and their heirs forever.

5. I will that upon the marriage of my wife that all my
property hitherto mentioned except my land be equally
divided between her and my children than and then alike
to them and their heirs forever. 6. I will that upon the Mar-
riage of my wife that one third part of my land including
my dwelling and out houses be laid off to her during
her natural life after her death to be equally divided between
my children as hereof directed. Lastly I do hereby appoint
and constitute my beloved wife Mary, my beloved Brother John
Harrar and my beloved friend Robert Ragland my Executor
and Executrix also Guardians to my children hoping that they
will assist in raising & educating them to the best advantage
as far as my Estate will permit, hereby revoking all other or
former Wills or Testaments by me hereof made. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this 27th day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand
eight hundred and twenty one —
