for fifty Acre, and two Negroes (ie) Sam & Petty, one Horse and
Saddle two Cows & Calves one feather Bed and furniture to him
and his heirs for ever - I give unto my Grand Daughter Be-
thania T. Johnson One Negro Girl named China, One woman
Saddle, one feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs
for ever - And my will and desire is that all and every of my
other lands not mentioned in this Will shall be sold to the
highest bidder or otherwise in order to satisfy all just debts
that may come against me - In testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 3d day
of October A.D. 1818 - And I do hereby appoint my beloved
Wife Bethania my whole & sole Executrix of this my last
Will and Testament -

Whereas I William Gillam of the County of Chatham and
State of North Carolina being of a sound mind and memory
and calling to mind the uncertainty of time and the necessity
of settling my outward affairs doth make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament revoking all others heretofore
made by me - Item 1. It is my will and desire that all my
just debts be paid as soon after my death as they conveniently
can by my executors and if there should not be money sufficient
on hand at such time to discharge the same that they

manner as they may think best to raise the money
Item 2^d. I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Jane
her husband during his natural life a part of the tract
of land wherein I now live bounded as follows beginning
at a white Oak near the Mouth of the Lane between lands
Lies land and my own running them with the lane that
nearly opposite the barn there with S. Lee line and Bryan
Cants line as their owners run until it strikes the pasture
line which include the pasture field known by the name
of the barn field thence run with said pasture line
until it strikes the fence near the head of the Meadow
thence down the Meadow fence so far as to strike the pasture
line between what is called the upper Meadow and lower
Meadow thence Northwardly in such a degree as will include
the dwelling and other necessary houses until it strikes the
fence above the House there with the fence leading to the
first station with privilege of cutting fire wood and also rail
timber sufficient to keep a good fence around the above
bounded inclosure off the other parts of the tract above men-
tioned. I also give and bequeath unto my wife two Cows her
choice, six sheep her choice three beds, one Horse her choice
together with all the Household and Kitchen furniture to
disposse of as she may think best. Item 3^e. I give and
bequeath unto my son Thomas Gillam five Shillings—
Item 4^f. I give and bequeath unto my son John the tract of
land wherein he now lives bounded as follows beginning at
Wm. W. Thompson's South West Corner thence running South of
that to a Maple marked in the glade above the house
thence a due West until it strikes John Branton's line
thence bounded by the S. Branton, Clarkson, Gathurst
Wm. W. Thompson's lands be the same man or less it is
my will to have it and hold for his own proper use
forever. Item 5^g. I give and bequeath unto my son Wm.

Gillam that part of land wheron I now live 47.
not heretofore devised at my death and also the land
which is bequeathed to his Mother at her death together
with all the Stock of every kind farming utensils and
property of every kind that is not heretofore devised nor
may hereafter be bequeathed and disposed of by my Ex-
ecutors to discharge the Money legacies & debts and so
is my will that he hold the land and property herein
bequeathed to him for ever. Item 6^h. I give and bequeath
to each of my following Daughters, Eliza, Mary Stephen,
Elizabeth Lee, Sarah Green, Mary Lewis and Sarah
Bruckner the sum of five Shillings to be paid them by
my Executors. Item 7ⁱ. I give and bequeath unto my
Daughter Peggy Gillam one Cow her choice after her Mother's
choice one Bed and furniture which she now claims—
Item 8^j. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca
Gillam one Cow her choice after her Mother and Peggy's
choice, and one Bed and furniture which she now claims
And lastly I appoint my worthy friend John Branton
and my son John my Executors of this my last will and
testament. In witness whereof I have caused to set my
