of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina being
of sound and perfect mind and memory I beseech you to bear
this truly thirtieth day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twenty two make and publish
this my last Will and Testament in manner following that
is to say first I give and recommend my soul to God who
gave it me and my body to the earth to be decently buried
at the direction of my Executors and friends, and as to my
Worlthy Estate as it has pleased God to bless me with in this
life I give and beleave it as follows, to wit, I give and bequeath
to my beloved Son Joseph Hackney & John Hackney and to my
beloved daughter Mary the wife of Clark Williams, Sally the
wife of Jonathan Buckard, Haffy the wife of Robert Bright,
Kenny the wife of William Henderson and Rachel the wife of
John Burke the sum of one Dollar each to be in full of their
several shares of my estate they having been heretofore advanced
by me. Then I give and bequeath to the Children of my beloved
daughter Betty formerly the wife of Charles Clark but now
deceased the sum of one Dollar, to be in full of their share
of my estate then Mother having been heretofore advanced
by me. Then I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Peggy
Hackney one Head Calf a Cow and Calves, eight
head of Hogs, five head sheep, all my Cows, Black and top
feeder, Sheepe & Swine now or hand, and also all the meat
and all the Cotton and flax both raw and spun, also one
Chair, six Chairs, one table two pots one Pinted Cem, one tea
Kettle, all my earthen Ware, all my plates, one Cupboard, one
flax Wheel, one Cotton Wheel, two pair Cotton Cards, one Rail, one
side Sashet, one Bridle, one plough and Gear, two Heding Hoes
one Axe all the water pails tubs and jugs, eight bushels
grain, all the poultry and the sum of twenty Dollars in Money
to her and her heirs for ever. It is further my will and desire
that my wife in making selection of the Stock, furniture

and tools hereby given to her shall be entitled to 55
take her choice. Item I bind to my said beloved wife Peggy
Hackney, three Beds bedsteads and furniture her choice
during her natural life or widowhood and in either the
event of her Death or Marriage to be then disposed of in
manner herein after mentioned or directed. Item It is my
will and desire that the residue of my Estate not before named
be sold at publick sale on such Credit as my Executors may
deem most advantageous to my Estate for the purpose of
paying my just Debts and that the residue of the Money
bearing from said sale together with the whole of my out-
standing debts due me after paying my debts aforesaid
be equally divided between my beloved Children, Ailey
Hackney, William Hackney, James Hackney and the Child
or Children with which my wife is now pregnant or the
survivor or survivors of them share and share alike to them
and their heirs forever, to be paid to them when they severally
arrive at Age or as necessity may require them. It is also my
will and desire that upon the death or Marriage of my wife
which event may first happen, the three Beds bedsteads
and furniture as aforesaid to her as before mentioned shall
be sold upon the like terms as the other property is directed
to be sold and the money arising from such sale be equally
divided between my said Children, Ailey Hackney, William
Hackney, James Hackney and the Child or Children with
which my wife is now pregnant or the survivor or sur-
vivors of them share and share alike to them and their
heirs forever, and I hereby make and direct my beloved
Son Joseph Hackney and my beloved wife Peggy Hackney
Executor and Executrix of this my last Will and Testa-
ment hereby revoking all former Wills by me man-

my last Will and Testament - I will and devise to my said
Executors all my land and real Estate of every description
which I now own or which may hereafter come to me either
by purchase or from my father's estate or otherwise (except
the lands where I now live containing by estimation up-
wards of seven hundred and fifty acres) to be sold by them
on such credit and at such times and in such manner as
they may judge most advantageous to the interest of my Estate
but in trust that they apply the proceeds of such sales
