

In the name of God Amen, I William Hamblat 63.  
Senior of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina being  
sick and weak in body, but of sound and disposing, mind and  
Memory, and duly Considering, that it is appointed for all men once  
to die, and being mindful of the uncertainty of that great Change  
when it shall please God to call me home I do therefore make publick  
and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner following,  
that is to say, first and principally, I commend my Soul into the hands  
of Almighty God my Creator who gave it, and my Body to the Earth  
to be interred at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named; and  
as to such Real and personal Estates wherof I am in any wise seized  
and possessed I describe of the same as followeth - In primis I bequeath  
unto my Wife Sarah Hamblat the plantation wherow I now live  
during her natural life at at her death I give and devise to my Son  
William that part of my Plantation wherow I live which lies to the  
East of the Spring Branch and to the East of a line drawn from the head  
of the Branch due North to my Northern line - Item the balance of  
my Land I give to my two daughters Sarah, and Sally after the death  
of my said Wife - Item I bequeath to my said Wife all my personal  
Estates be it of what kind, sort or nature soever of which I may die possessed  
during her natural life to use and enjoy and to sell such part of the  
Stock and its increase as she may from time to time think proper  
for family Consumption and after her death I desire that my Executors  
hereinafter named shall hire out or otherwise dispose of as they shall  
deem most proper one Negro slave named Benjamin for the use  
and benefit of my Son Richard Hamblat and his heirs - Item  
It is my desire that my Executors shall likewise hire out or otherwise  
dispose of as they shall deem most proper one Negro boy named Tony after  
the death of my said Wife for the use and benefit of my daughter Betty  
Goodwin or her heirs - Item It is my will and desire that after the  
death of my said Wife the Negro slaves of which I am now possessed  
shall be disposed of as follows viz To my Son William Hamblat I give

Give a negro man named Harry, to my Daughter & shee shall  
a negro woman named Muriel, to my Daughter Fanny Hamblett  
give a negro woman named Suskey, to my Daughter Charity Hamblett  
I give a negro woman named Penny, to my Daughter Lydia Hamblett  
I give a negro girl named Louisa, to my Daughter Sally Hamblett  
I give a negro girl named Polly, to my Daughter Emily Hamblett I give a  
negro girl named Betty, and to my Daughter Polly Betty I give a negro  
boy named Elias, and in case of the death of any of my said  
Children before me or my said Wife it is my desire that their share  
left alive at the time of their death shall have such share as their  
Parent would have had if living. Then I give to my Daughter  
the Bed and furniture now called her, and it is my desire that at  
the death of my said Wife she shall likewise have a Cow and  
Calf, and if there should not be one at that time then that my  
Executor out of the proceeds of the sale of my perishable Estate  
shall either buy her one or give her its equivalent in money,  
+ Then it is my desire that the future increase of my female slaves  
to the time of the death of my said Wife shall be sold and divided  
between my Children or their Heirs equally - I desire that after the  
death of my said Wife all the Stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep, and  
Hogs, all my Household and Kitchen furniture, Plantation utensils and  
Crop which shall be at the time of the death of my said Wife shall  
be sold by my Executor hereinafter named and after paying all  
my Just debts and funeral expenses and the funeral expenses of my said  
Wife (except the Cow and Calf hereinafter mentioned for my Daughter  
Sally) to be equally divided between all my Children -  
Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Son William  
Hamblett and my friends Jesse West and Charles S. Williams Executors to  
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills  
by me at any time hereof made. In witness whereof I the said  
William Hamblett have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth  
day of February in the year of our Lord 1872.

also I give to her three Notes of hand each for one hundred dollars due  
from William Harp also I give to her one Note of hand due from the  
said Harp for some more than forty dollars and I hereby acknowledge  
this to be my last Will and Testament disannulling and revoking all others  
heretofore made - Witness my hand and seal -
