executors thereof and request them to become Guardians

my hand and seal this thirtieth day of July A.D. 1820

In the name of God. Amen. I William Prince of
Chatham County being of sound and perfect mind and
memory (blessed be God) do this ninth day of June in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
make and publish this my last will and testament in
manner following (that is to say) First I give and bequeath
to my loving Wife Elizabeth the following Negroes viz, Tony
Amy, Moss & Cindy with all her Children also my Best Man
one Choice Bed & furniture One hundred Dollars of ^{the} Money
due me here and my claim in Virginia - Secondly I will
that my Executor sell all the residue of my Estate of whatsoever
kind it may be at Publick Sale (except one little Negro girl
Earthen which I have before given to William Nicholas Prince
& pay my debts out of the proceeds thereof and the ballance
if any to go to the Heirs of my Sister Mary Lawrence
lawfully begotten of her body. Thirdly I will that my Executor
keep my property together & finish the Crop now growing
before he sell it as above directed and then include it
with the rest of my property which I want disposed of in
the same way.

Lastly, I hereby make and Ordain my brother Edmund
Prince Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In
Witness whereof I the said William Prince have to this
my last Will & Testament set my hand & Seal the day and
year above written - Signed sealed published and declared
by the said William Prince the testator as his last will
and testament in the presence of us who were present at
the time of signing & sealing thereof -

The following is my last Will and testament -

1. I direct my Executor herein after named to pay all my
last debts & burial expence - 2nd My Wife Mary to have full
possession of my whole Estate whatever during her widowhood
and in case she marries one half of the personal existing
at that period at her Death or Marriage to sell the whole
Estate and Divide as follows - 3rd to George son of Simon
Rutbottow one hundred Dollars 4th Ezekiel Mazy twenty
Dollars - and his sister Ann ten Dollars 5th to Robert Prince
Daughter Mary & Hannah each ten Dollars 6th To my
Legates now named the residue of my Estate to be
divided in portions as follow - To Phoebe Rutbottow nine
shares, to Joshua Dixon six shares to the Children of
my Brother Enoch Dixon namely Sarah & Amor each
one share - To the Children of my Brother Caleb Dixon
namely Ann, Susanna, Dinah, Rebecca, Hannah, Emy
Jonathan, Daniel, George and Mary each one share
I appoint Simon Rutbottow & Stephen White to execute
