 Carolina being sick and weak in body, but of perfect mind
 and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in
 manner and form following. First. It is my Will that all
 my Just debts should be paid. Secondly. I give and bequeath
 to Marion Lamb one Hopper & fifty acres of Land with the
 improvement thereon where she now lives to have the hold

291 the same as long as she lives shall live; at her death I
give the said fifty acres of Land to her daughter, Mariah
and her heirs forever. I also give Mariah Hannah and
one old Chest and one Feather Bed and Furniture of said
Bed. Also I give and bequeath to my son Josiah Reger
the balance of my Land with the improvement when I
now live. I also give to my son Josiah Reger the rest residue
and remainder of my personal estate, except what has been
given away before. Lastly, I constitute and appoint Peter
Long son's executor of this my last Will and Testament
revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty
first day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred & twenty.
