I, Alfred Morgan, of the State and County aforesaid, do make and declare this my last will and Testament.

- I will that my body be buried in the simplest manner and ~~the~~ with the least expense ~~and~~ and display consistent with decency and the expense of same to come out of the first money coming into the hands of my executors.

- I will and bequeath to my wife Ada Jane Morgan all of that part of the tract of land known as the Patsy Johnson Place except what lies on the North or North-east side of the old public road which was built by Charlie Wood.

- I will and bequeath to my wife Ada Jane, and my six children Esther Anna Rufus Ralph Lucy and Laura all the real estate I may be possessed at the time of my death excepting the Patsy Johnson Place mentioned in Sec 2 as willed and bequeathed to my wife, Ada Jane Morgan, my real estate at this date consisting of the Astor Hughes land, the Mayford higher land and the land bought (but not deed yet) from B.E. Warner.

- I will that any and all personal property I may own at time of my death be divided equally among my wife, Ada Jane Morgan and my six children Esther Anna Rufus Ralph Lucy and Laura.

- I have agreed to exchange that part of the Patsy Johnson Place to Ben Warner for a 60 acre tract of land he owns adjoining my Astor Hughes land. If this exchange will not have been consummated at the time of my death it is my will that my executor consume it.
