

Georgia, Tannin County.

I, Thompson A. Terrell, of said county, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking any and all wills which I have heretofore made.

Item 1. It is my will and desire that my body be buried in a Christianlike manner, the place and details of which leave to my wife and children.

Item 2. It is my will and desire that all of my just debts be paid as soon as practicable after my death.

Item 3. I will, bequeath, and devise all my property, both real and personal, of whatever kind and whomever situated, to my wife, Ida Terrell, during her natural life or widowhood, and in the event of her marrying again, then so that said property is to revert to my children hereinafter mentioned, except that my wife, Ida Terrell, is to have a child's part in said estate though she should marry again. And it is my will that should my wife, Ida Terrell, marry again, then all of my property shall be sold to the highest bidder and be equally divided between my three children, to-wit: William Horton Thompson and Joe Terrell and my wife, Ida Terrell.

Item 4. I leave my wife, Ida Terrell, in full charge of my estate during her natural life or widowhood, and she together with Thompson Terrell and Joe Terrell, I hereby name executors of this will, and I relieve them from giving bond, and from making inventory of my property, of appraisement thereof, and they are required only by this will to probate the will, and they are further relieved from making any returns of their acts and doings to any court.
