Isaac Thomas Senior of Guilford County and Lot of Seneca do this 1st day of December 1858 make and obtain this my last will and Testament as to all ~~my~~ the lands and tenements I own and am interested in in the State of North Carolina and also as to the proceeds of any judgments that may recover against the heirs of John Caldwell begin with the individuals of said John Caldwell as a partner in the Great Smoky Company the partners in which company were the said John Caldwell L. S. Senior & P. Senior & B. B. Senior and I P. Senior as partly an ~~and~~ whole of agreement between the said parties to which reference is made. No other effects are, or ever were, interest in a tract of land known as lot 14, 67 United of Cherokee County North Carolina containing 14 acres & about 33 acres of Town Commons of Murphy adjoining lot 14 and may be considered as part of the same tract of land. Also one fourth interest in lot 108 lying North of lot 106 and also in the same tract and the one fourth interest of lot 108 in the same tract bought of ~~the same~~ and wife. Also now three shares being 1/3 of lot 106 containing five acres of land ore and ~~three~~ valuable minerals and another share I may hereafter acquire. Also the one fourth of the one fourth of the mineral interest now being principles in one hundred and eighty loads of land conveyed to L. S. Senior William Senior B. B. Senior and Serial P.
