George and John Williams Senes in this is included an oblation
on the part of George for the one eighth of five hundred acres
on the West of house branch, was one fourth of the one
fourth of the annual interest such being privileges of
land of Lane George & me by the purchase which I believe
is 1813 it being the same on which is the old Grant
George & me by Robert in the Town Church St.
which is Registered in Lincoln County and Robert's return
is hereby made and is made a part of this instrument
all of which intent and parts of intent of Partnerships
and Company intent and Claims I request and
desire to John Thomas McCall Thomas Gegg McCall and
Elizabeth McCall during her natural life

I make my last will and testament in witness
of this will with full power to carry out its provision
I hereby certify on 1st page and 5th line from bottom
before this will is executed it is a full return on 1st page
written out true copy of interest 1st line from bottom
1st page before signing
