I John C. Griffin of Coneta Cherokee County North
Carolina being infirm in body but of sound mind
do make this my last will and Testament
1st I give my body to the grave and my soul to God

2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid and fully
satisfied and to that end and purpose I hereby give
and bequeath to my wife Francis Elizabeth Griffin all
my Real Estate in fee simple that I am now seized
and possessed of consisting of Ten acres of land on which
my Residence and Slave house is situated also 143 acres of
land bought of John Brim also 100 acres of land bought
of John Griffin all situated lying and being in Beaverdam
Township Cherokee County North Carolina for more particular
and minute description thereof reference is hereby
made to book of record in the Register of Deeds office
of Cherokee County N.C. I further give and bequeath
unto my wife Francis Elizabeth all my personal property
consisting of Stock of goods in Slave one Yoke of cattle
and ten young Cows Calves also all my household
goods to have and enjoy during her natural life time
also all my debts due me accounts and notes all
evidence of debt which I desire collected and ap-
propriated to the discharge of all my indebtedness
3rd I desire that an inventory of all my goods and
merchandise be made and that my son Wm Augustus
Griffin take charge of the same and continue the
business the same as I might or could do if able to
do so, the profit and emoluments of the said business
to him to W.A. Griffin saving and excepting the comfortable
support and maintenance of my wife Francis Elizabeth
during her natural life and to provide decent interment
at her death

4th I hereby appoint my wife Francis Elizabeth
Griffin my sole Executor without bond with full
power to sell & make deeds in fee simple to all my
Real Estate, that it may be necessary to do to pay
my debts and to comfortable maintain her during
her natural life and to fully carry out in all

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details this my last Will and Testament I further enjoin
upon my said Executor the ultimate disposition of my
property both Real and personal as follows
an equal distribution of the residue of my effects
at her death to my natural heirs at her death viz
To Martha Ann wife of A.J. Kilpatrick One Eighth
" Margaret Anne Griffin one eighth
" John Thomas Griffin one eighth
" Francis Elizabeth wife of W.C. Hammond one eighth
" Benjamin Bluford Griffin one eighth
" Mary Isbell wife of Dr G. G. Whitecombe one eighth
" Susan Blundin wife of H.M. McCamy one eighth
" William Augustus Griffin one eighth

I request that my said heirs if they can agree to do so
to continue the business I have established from generation
to generation and enjoy the proceeds thereof share and share
alike and I particularly request and enjoin upon
them to care for and protect my wife's interests and
see that all the provisions hereof are carried out and
to see that nothing is squandered with power to select
and appoint an executor in place of my wife at
her death for illness at her request

Stallop upon the Consideration and Special Trust that the said Shady H. Stallop shall provide food and raiment for myself and my wife Adaline suitable to our dexterous and to furnish medical services during our natural lives and pay all our funeral expenses or cause the same to be done and paid and for the further Consideration and Special trust that the said James H. Stallop Shady H. Stallop and Hugh D. Stallop shall pay at my death two hundred dollars each making the total of six hundred dollars to my other heirs to wit Mary Amanda Stallop Charles H. Stallop Sarah A. Stallop Henry V. Stallop John W. Stallop and Naomi E.
