

Recall of Wills and Testament of Juan

August 10th
1869

I J. M. Percy of the County of Cherokee and State of North Carolina being of Sound Mind and Memory and considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say, First that my Executor hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts however and whensoever coming out of the money that my first name into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate, It is my desire that my cattle be sold first to pay all my just debts, It is my wish that all my real estate be left to my children in common until my youngest Son Francisco P. Percy becomes of age and then they can dispose of the land as they see proper, and all my other personal property be kept on the farm for the use of my children and the farm, with the exception of my Watch I want it to be kept until my youngest Son Francisco P. Percy becomes twenty one years old I then want it handed to him and tell him that it is his father's old watch, and my Cyrenetic instrument I give to the first one of my sons that comes to Germany, all the debts that is due me It is my wish that they be collected without distressing, the people that are due me, and I do hereby constitute and appoint my truly friend M. L. Brittain and my son W. B. Percy my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the Same and every clause thereof hereby declaring and disclaiming literary or other rights and Testaments by me heretofore made, in witness whereof I the said J. M. Percy hereunto set my hand and seal the 10th day July 1869
