 all and singular, the legal right to which
 I might be entitled if then living but
 nothing in this writing shall be construed
 as giving any present or vested share
 share no force while after my death
 but then I shall have full and absolute
 effect to the full extent of giving my
 said wife every possible right title in
 Arona or in the British Colonies or elsewhere
 that I have or could have if myself
 living and demanding the same in
 my own name and in my own right
 within my name and not after the
 the 14 day of January in the year of
 our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty
 nine
