County and State aforesaid, being of sound mind but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make, publish and declare this my last Will and Testament;

First: My Executors hereinafter named shall give my body a decent burial, pursuant to the wishes of my wife and friends, and pay all funeral expenses, together with all my just debts out of any money on hand at my death, belonging to my estate.

Second: I give and devise to my beloved wife Oliver Elvira Hall, all my lands, consisting of part of tract No. Eleven, and Tracts, and Tract No. Two and sit in the Fourth District of Chowan County for and during the term of her natural life.

Third: I give and devise to Eva Hall, wife of Andrew J. Hall, all that part of tract No. Eleven lying North East of a line beginning on a ditch near the mouth of the branch that runs by my residence, bearing North 32 degrees West to the line of tract No. 12, also tract to his Mountain land, after the death of my said wife, for and during the term of her natural life, and after her death, then to any children of the said Eva Hall that may survive her, or the representatives of such as are dead; if there be such, in fee.

Fourth: I give and devise to Allen Martin, in consideration of his services to my wife and self tract No. 5, and all that part of tract No. Eleven not devised to Eva Hall in paragraph to them above now owned by me, after the death of my said wife, to him in fee.

Fifth: I give and devise to A. Benjamin Martin all that part of tract No. Five which I now own, after the death of said wife, to be his in fee.

Sixth: All my personal property of every kind and description, that my remain after payment of any just debts and funeral expenses, including money

on hand, notes, account, stocks, household and kitchen furniture and the like, and I give and bequeath to my said wife to be by her used, enjoyed and disposed of as she sees fit.

Seventh: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved wife, Oliver Elvira Hall, my lawful execatrix, to all intents and purposes, to execute this my last Will and Testament, according to the true intent and meaning of the same, and my part and share thereof, hereby revoking all other wills and testaments by me hitherto made.
