I, M P Whitcomb of the Town of Murphy in the County of Cherokee and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life do therefore make certain published and declare this to be my last will and testament.

That is to say first after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged the residue of my estate real and personal I give bequeath and devise as follows to wit. First I give and bequeath my son Charles Gardner Whitcomb & of Chicago my house and lot on Campbell Street and Springdale Avenue for better description refer to record of deed from A. A. Campbell and wife and I further bequeath to the aforesaid Charles Gardner Whitcomb my feather bed pillows two red blankets and my new Carpet & pink Covered trunk red album quitt and also my Persian Shawl.

This I do in Consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars which has been given to me by my son Charles Gardner Whitcomb at different times to aid me in building and to support me and pay debts which I contracted I give to Elath Miller Whitcomb my pin and badge of the Kings daughters to my son George Gay Whitcomb I give and bequeath all my house hold goods and kitchen furniture books &c not mentioned above Sewing machine bedstead tables stove &c &c Likewise I make and appoint and constitute J S Meroney son to be my Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

Also I bequeath to Jessie Whitcomb my butter Knife and sugar spoon my reliefs and Clock.

I wish to be understood that I have by this will forgiven the moneys borrowed from me by J. G. Whitcomb One hundred and fifty dollars in 1875 and one hundred and nineteen dollars in or about 1886.
