In the name of god Amen I Angus Ray of the  
State of North Carolina Cumberland County do  
make this my last will and testament being in per-  
fect health and sound of mind hereby revoking  
all my will and wills by me before made, first I  
do resign comit and offer my soul & body to god in the  
most holy trinity most humbly beseeching him to give  
me light rest & mercy both now and forever for the sake  
and satisfaction of my most adored saviour Jesus Christ  
Amen, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret  
Ray during her natural life one hundred acres of land  
in P. County wheron I now live with <sup>house</sup> & kitchen furniture  
& other utensils thereunto belonging all my plantation  
tools and after her disease I give & bequeath the P. one hundred  
acres of land & all thereunto belonging to my son John & his  
heirs forever, likewise I give & bequeath to my sd wife  
Margaret my best horse sheep hogs & one half of my  
cattle, I give and devise to my son John Ray a tract of  
land containing fifty acres lying on Millsons Creek  
in the County aforesd also a tract of land of fifty six  
acres lying on the East side of P. Creek, likewise a negro  
man named Bob & Negro woman named Phillip, and the  
rest of my horses & other half of my cattle to him the  
Said John Ray and his heirs forever, I give and bequeath  
to my grand son Archibald Ray one Negro girl  
named Jane, likewise I give & devise to my grand son
