In the name of god Amen I Angus Ray of the
State of South Carolina Cumberland County do
make this my last will and testament being in per-
fect health and sound of mind hereby revoking
all & every will and wills by me before made, first I
do resign commit and offer my soul & body to god in the
most holy trinity, most humbly beseeching him to give
me light rest & mercy, both now and forever for the sake
and satisfaction of my most adored saviour Jesus Christ
Amen, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret
Ray during her natural life one hundred acres of land
in S. County whereon I now live with ^{house} & kitchen furniture
& other utensils thereunto belonging, all my plantation
tools and after her decease I give & bequeath the S. one hundred
acres of land & all thereunto belonging to my son John & his
heirs forever, likewise I give & bequeath to my S. wife
Margaret my best horse, sheep, hogs & one half of my
cattle, I give and devise to my son John Ray, a tract of
land containing fifty acres lying on Micoons Creek
in the County afores. also a tract of land of fifty six
acres lying on the East side of S. Creek, likewise a negro
man named bob & negro woman named Phillis, and the
rest of my horses & ^{the} other half of my cattle to him the
Said John Ray and his heirs forever, I give and bequea-
th to my grand son Archibald Ray one negro girl
named Jane, likewise I give & devise to my grand son
