Carolina Though weak in body yet of sound and
disposing mind do on this the 25 of July A.D. 1850
make ordain publish and declare this paper to
contain and be my last will and testament in &
form as follows First after my death I desire to be
Buried in a place and becoming name near or where
My deceased and beloved wife is buried That my Executors
here after named pay the Expences of the same of
the first money that shall come in to their hand Dever
law to my Estate Item 2. it is my desire that all my
just debts to be paid as soon as convenient from the following
funds &c All such personal property as is not willed
by me shall be sold on a credit of six Monthly All that
are in my possession at my death shall be hired out
till such debts as I owe with the sale of the personal
property as will be sufficient to pay those and if necessary
any my Executors are authorized to borrow the Money
from the Bank at Fayetteville or other wise as will
necessary to pay those debts and Refund them from the
dt above Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Mrs Margaret Monroe for and during
her natural life the following Negroes slaves
to Dinah Polley Ben & Alice together with their
increase Item 4^d That after the death of my daughter
Mrs Margaret Monroe I give and bequeath to such
living children as the Said Margaret Shall leave
the following Negroes limited over to the Said
Margaret & Dinah Polley Ben & Alice and their
increase Item 5^d I give and bequeath to my
son John Mc Loran the following Negroes
slaves & Sam & Lida Margaret and their increase
I all so give and desire to him one part of my

land on the North side of the swamp that is
 the south side devide ^{between} him & Brother Thomas
 the devideing to comence at Alpine well known where
 little John Melvin was thrown from his horse and
 to ran due East and west that on the south side
 to be Johns also one halfe my saw mill to have and
 to hold during his naturall life and ~~to be sold~~
 at his death all of the above named Negroes lands
 & to such children as the said John shall leave
 surviving him Item 6^o I give and bequeath to my
 sonne Thos H. L. Loran the following Negroes slaves
 & Sarah Tom and Catharine and there increase & also
 devise to a part of land on the North side of swamp
 and that part of said land as layt joining next to him
 the south or other part of said land is given
 to my sonne John as stated above to be devideed as
 stated in Johns line Thomas taken the Northern part
 of this land one halfe of my saw mill I also give
 and bequeath to my sonne Thomas my timber wagon and
 teams with the necessary gear

Item 7^o I give and bequeath to my sonne Daniel H.
 Loran the following Negroes slaves & Easter William and
 Amanda and there increase & also devise to him all the
 Notes and accompts that I hold against him to be
 given him free of all charges

Item 8^o I give and bequeath to my grand daughter
 Nancy H. Loran the following Negroes slaves and her
 increase

Item 9^o give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary H.
 Loran the following Negroes slaves Mary Richard
 Jenah June and Neal with there increase also one
 mowee and the young Mare colt

Item 10^o I give and bequeath to my daughter Agness H.
 Loran the following Negroes slave & violet Daniel

and Charely together with there increase I also give unto
 Devise to her the griff Mill and the Land on the south of
 the Big ditch and all the improvements there on
 the ditch to be the devouding line betwix her and her
 Brothers, Permitting such of here sisters as may wish
 to live with her to do so free of Rent I also give her
 my horse Jeff and my Buggay and harness all the
 lawfull heirs to have there grift ground toll free
 that will asiste in keeping the mill in repare
 all of the property here in designated to Return to the
 legal heirs at the Death of Daughter Agneiss
 Item 11^d I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mrs
 Isabella Jones the following Negro slaves Jack Isabella
 and Prilla I also give devise to my said Daughter
 Isabella one hundred acres of land joining John Gade
 and others for and during here lifetime and after her
 death the whole of the above named property to go to
 back to the lawful heirs
 Item 12^e I also give to my Daughter Elizabeth Mc
 Laran and bequeath to same the following Negro slaves
 Mariah Moses Rachel and Eliza together with there
 increase Item 13 I give and bequeath to my son
 Robert Mc Laran the following Negro slaves
 & Barbare and Archibald together with there
 increase I also give and devise to my said son
 Robert one hundred Acres of land other buck etka
 Creek being in two Survey's Joining Jones and others
 timber Excepted untill the debts are paid
 Item 14^f I also give and bequeath to my three
 Daughters Namely Mary Agness and Elizabeth
 one cow and calf Each of them to take choice
 commenring with the oldest down to the young-
 est also Each Daughter one Bed furniture and
 13 Bed Steads

Item 15^d Should either of my Sons or Son in laws raise or have any notes or accounts against me they are to receive the same from the Legacy's here given and not from any other part of my Estate

Item 16^d The negroes slaves Adam Haney and Robert not willed to any of the heirs herein mentioned the aforesaid slaves Adam Haney and Robert to be hired out and the prospeds to be applied to the payment of my debts and when all my debts are paid the above Negroes Adam Haney and Robert to be divided amonsgt the heires as the Executors deeme fit

Item 17^d I do here by Revoke and declare all other wills made by me here to fore to be null and void and of no affect

And lastly I do hereby appoint Constable my Son John as M^r Loran and my friend Malcom M^r Millan to be my Executors to this my last will and testament signed sealed published and declared to be the last will and testament in presence of us and in presence of each other this the 25th of July A.D 1850
