

I Caroline Martha Winslow do declare
the following to be my last Will & Testament:

I give, devise and bequeath, to John
Winslow and Warren Winslow and the survivors
of them, all my places, together with their in-
crease & land after this date, to have and to hold
the same in trust for the benefit & use of
Edward L. Winslow my son, or to have the same
& pay him the same or to dispose of them, at his
discretion for his benefit and use, until such
time as some creditor of the said Edward L. shall
attempt by any proceeding, at law or in equity, to
subject them to his debt, and then and in that event,
the trust for the said Edward L. shall cease and
determine, and the Trustees shall hold for the use
and benefit of all the children of the said Edward
L., who may be then living - The whole of the
above property to be subject to and charged primarily,
with the payment of Four Thousand Dollars to
Marion A. & Elizabeth A. Winslow children of
said Edward L. Winslow, to pay and their ad-
vance.

Any other property I have, to be divided
among my grand children, as my Executors
may determine.

I give, devise and bequeath, to John
Winston and Warren Winston and the survivors
of them, all my slaves, together with their in-
crease born after this date, to have and to hold
the same in trust for the benefit use of
Edward L. Winston my son, or to him whom
I may hereafter direct or to dispose of them, at their
discretion for his benefit and use, until such
time as some creditor of the said Edward L. shall
attempt by any proceeding, at law, or in equity, to
subject them to his debt, and then and in that event,
the trust for the said Edward L. shall cease and
determine, and the Trustees shall hold for the use
and benefit of all the children of the said Edward
L., who may be then living - The whole of the
above property to be subject to and charged primarily,
with the payment of Four Thousand Dollars to
Marion & Elizabeth L. Winston children of
said Edward L. Winston to pay and their endow-
ments.

Any other property I have, to be divided
among my grand children, as my Executors
may determine.

I appoint John & Warren Winston my Executors
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal, this 23^d day of June 1859.
