In the name of god amen I Daniel Patterson of the State of North Carolina and County of Cumberland Sd Daniel Patterson being very Sore and weak in body but of a perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto god therefore calling unto the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament viz, principally first of all I give and Recommend unto the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at general Resurrection I shall Receive the Same again by mighty power of god. as Touching Such worldly Estate whereas it hath pleased god to bestow on this life I give demise and dispose of in the following manner and form.

First that all my debts be satisfied then I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Katharine the two tracts of land whereon I now live her lifetime if my son Duncan Returns back then to be Equally divided between him and Daniel B. Patterson if Duncan never comes to be left to my Daughter Katharin and Daniel B. Patterson Secondly a third track of land daughter Mary Thirdly I leave one mare and a horse to the use of the plantation under the care of Daniel B. Patterson if Duncan Comes back to be Equally divided between him and Daniel B. Patterson Fourthly I give to my daughter Mary one cow Fifthly I give to Daniel B. Patterson two shears Sixthly I give to my wife all the best of my stock Seventhly I give to my step Daughter Jennet B. one bed and furniture one cow between her and my daughter Mary all the best of my farming utensils to the use of the use of the plantation all my household furniture to the use of the plantation except one pot to my Daughter a Mary my blacksmith tools and part of the still to Daniel B. Patterson and Duncan

In the name of God Amen!
I Daniel Patterson of Cumberland
county N^C Carolina being minded
of my mortality & of sound mind
and memory (blessed be God) do this
second day of November in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred & thirty three, make this my
last will and testament in manner
and form following that is to say -
First. I devise & bequeath unto my
son William Patterson two hundred
acres of land with their appurtenances,
one hundred of which is situate on the
head of the Bear dam & the other
hundred in two surveys adjoining
the Mary Shaw land. Also young
William, being now two children Hannah
& Henry & all her future increase -
Item, To my son Lech Patterson
I devise two hundred & fifty acres of
land with the appurtenances which
include the plantation whereon
I now live. Also fifty acres of land
called the Angus Holiday survey.
I bequeath to said Lech Patterson
my negroe woman Harriet & her son
Miles & all her future increase -
Item, To my daughter Sarah I give
and bequeath my negroe woman Judy,
a cow & calf -
Item, To my daughter Elizabeth I give
and bequeath my negroe man Polly about sixty
six years old

Item To my daughter Flora, I give
and bequeath my negroe boy Turquill
about six years old and at her death
provided she dies without issue the said
boy is to go to my son Malcom and
Edith equally —

Item To my daughter Louisa, I give
and bequeath my negroe woman
Soasy about 50 years of age

Item To my son Malcom & Edith
I also give & bequeath A. C. C. C.

Item To my son Arthur & my daughter
Flora I give & bequeath all the
residue of my property not here in
already disposed of —

Lastly I nominate my two sons
Malcom & Arthur Executors to this
my last will & testament and
I hereby revoke & annul all former
wills by me made In witness
whereof I the said Daniel Patterson have
hereunto subscribed my name & affixed my
seal the day & year first above written
Signed sealed published
& declared in the presence of Daniel Patterson
us who have attested the
same in the presence of the
testator & in the presence of
each other
