The Last will and testament of Daniel Ray of Cumberland County in the province of North Carolina sheweth he is being weak in Body Body Perfect mind and memory and considering his worldly Estate he is Desirous that after his Death it shall be sold and divided in the following order Viz that the whole should be sold at a public sale and that the money shall be left to the Care and Management of John Ray and Hugh Ray till they get an Opportunity to send it To Scotland to his Brother Even Ray or if any of his Brothers Comes from Scotland to this place that I Desire that John and Hugh Ray shall send with Deliver the Money unto the first that comes of them Excepting one two year old daughter I Desire that the said Margaret Graham Daughter to John Graham to enjoy the same forever, but in Case that the said John and Hugh Ray cannot get an Opportunity to send it to Scotland and that either of his Brothers Comes to this place he Desire that John and Hugh Ray will Enjoy the Money Each of them one half during my land Thus 15th of April 1761
