 resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
 of God, and as to such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased
 God to bless me with in this life I give demise & dispose of in the fol-
 lowing manner (Viz: In the first place I desire that all my just
 be paid by my Executors, Then I give and bequeath to my
 beloved Wife all my household furniture and one half of the Cattle
 horses and use of the land and plantation whereon I now live &
 for Life, also I give to my well beloved nephew Daniel Shaw gun
 negro, fellowes names Jack and George and all my lands which is in two surveys, one tract lying on the June per a branch
 of Spawto Creek containing 150 acres another piece lying on August
 branch joining Seall Shaws back line containing 100 acres the said
 hereditaments and appurtenances I do absolutely give and bequeath
 to my said nephew Daniel Shaw gun his heirs Executors and assigns
 for ever in fee simple, also I give and bequeath to Duques Shaw son of
 Seall Shaw one half of my Cattle and horses And I do appoint my
 beloved Wife my executrix with my nephew Daniel Shaw and
 my nephew Seall Shaw and my Executors of this my last will & testament
 revoking all other wills & testaments by me made in writing or other-
 wise I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29 day of May A.D. 1752

 testament of the said Duncan Shaw in presence of us
