- 2.nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Willkins
all the rest and residue of property of whatsoever
it may consist, to be freely used and enjoyed by her
during her natural life, granting to her the privilege
of disposing of or applying it or any part thereof
to any use or in any way she may think necessary
to her support.
- 3.rd Should there remain or be left any part of the
property I now devise to my wife Mary at her
decease, I desire that my Nephew Williams Prouty
receive the same to his own proper use & benefit for ever
And lastly.

I do hereby ordain & appoint my friend
James A. Byrnes Executor of this my last Will & Testament
in which of I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 27th day of May in the year of our Lord 1830
