 Daughters of Allen Utley may have my bed and furniture to
 them and their heirs forever
 Item, I desire that Green Utley may have my pot, one pewter
 dish four pewter plates knives and forks and three hogs &
 one pewter basin to him and his heirs forever
 Item my desire is that Dorcas Utley Daughter of Allen
 Utley may have my four earthen plates three cups & saucers
 and two bottles to her and her heirs forever
 Item my desire is that my children Littleton Yarbrough, Judith
 Taylor, Elizabeth H. ward, Frances Youngblood,
²¹⁵ Miron Yarbrough and Moses Gilham may each of

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 them have full Shillings to them & their heirs forever.
 Lastly I do appoint Allen Utley Executor of this my last will
 and testament hereby revoking and annulling all other
 wills whatever, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my

 tober One Thousand eight hundred and two
