 testament first of all I give my soul to God

 Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
 mighty power of God and as to what property
 the Lord has blessed me with I give it in
 the following manner to wit viz
 I give and bequeath to my Brother David
 Walker one feather bed and furniture and
 all my share in my sisters Dicy property and
 all and singular every thing that is due me in
 any way what ever
 I give and bequeath to Dicy Morrison all my
 wearing clothes and I hereby nominate and
 appoint my Brother David Walker Executor to this
 my last will and testament and I hereby revoke and
 disannul all other wills in writings or wheresoever
 I have heretofore set my hand and seal the day and date
 written in the presence of us
