 Ramsay being of sound mind and Memory and considering the
 uncertainty of this mortal Life do make this my last Will and
 Testament in manner and form following First I
 leave and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Ramsay
 the town and Lands of Lower Dornish known by the name
 of the Town of Linnacina now in the Possession of
 Andrew mt. Glene Charles Stewart John Stewart William
 Stewart and Robert Mt. Glene as also Christy Bains with
 two acres of reserved Land and two sumo grassing with all their
 Appurtenances to her and her heirs forever reserving them
 thirty pounds Sterling p. ann. as a Jointure or maintenance for
 my wife Jean Ramsay at mt. Donald During her
 Life or widowhood And my will that my said ~~Wife~~
 Interest in said Lands be Subject to my said grand daughter
 But not my wife's Jointure the rent of the whole
 town and Lands amounting to £53: 6d. with
 Duty. I also leave and bequeath my said Daughter
 Elizabeth the Town and Lands of Lower Dornish
 now Enjoy'd by her Grandfather Charles Ramsay
 and his tenants, as also the town of woodlan
 Dornish with Donald mt. Neal's farm with my
 property in the water Course which is farmed by
 the Inhabitants of Balliboy with the Tuff
 bog work is farmed by the Inhabitants afores. from her
 said Grandfather Charles with all my right
 property and Interest to the Vicar of Caithwork
 with the farm called Castle nansen and the work of

Subject Hereunto to the payment of a sum of money
 of any sort to be paid to the payment of thirty
 pounds which I owe to Charles Ramsey on the
 1st of June 1663 the like sum of thirty pounds to
 Edward Ramsey son to John Ramsey (the
 like sum of thirty pounds to Edward Ramsey
 son to John Ramsey and Brother to said Edward and also
 to be paid to Francis Ramsey Daughter
 to Edward Ramsey in the sum of twenty
 pounds. All these legacies to be paid as above. It is
 also my will that in case of the death of my said Daughter
 Elizabeth that my said wife and her heirs shall be entitled to the
 whole term of years which I now possess being 30
 a year and a half of the said land and with a power
 in case of her second marriage of raising a hundred pounds
 on said lands and no sign here. I also have and
 bequeath to my said wife and her heirs of land in
 Chesham Brook containing 14. 2. 23 of land with is M^{rs} Gage
 to John Gage for 10 years money payable in
 twelve months from the 2^d of July 1663 being in full
 of all due from said M^{rs} Gage. I also have my
 said wife and her heirs right and property to a tract of 50
 acres of land lying South by from Soler having
 London Dock Creek remains 25/ to be paid for Balint
 next Court of Claims I also have and bequeath to my
 said wife and her heirs by John Walker for seven
 pounds and also one bond due
 by Lauck Dougherty for fifteen pounds

of like currency as also one Prosspay note
 by the Bonds for six pounds of like currency as
 now in the possession of James Bond at the Sign of
 Lord London Street Philadelphia who
 had a power of Attorney to sue for them. I also have
 and bequeath to the Sons of the Parish of St. Andrew
 and County Down where my lands lie the sum of
 ten pounds being real objects. And lastly I
 do hereby nominate and appoint my said wife
 the sole executrix of this my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking and Disannulling all former wills
 by me heretofore made. For Witness whereof
 I have hereunto put my hand and seal this 10th
 day of July 1663
