Be it known unto all
men that I G. S. Rollins of the County and State
aforesaid do make and declare this my last
will and Testament. In manner and form
following. That is to say first after my decease
I desire that my Executor herein after named
shall provide for my body a decent burial
suitable to the wishes of my relatives and
friends, and pay all funeral expenses
out of the first moneys that may come into
his hands as a parcel of my estate.

1st Item I will and devise to my Brother
Peyton P. Rollins Seventy five acres of Land
off of the North end of the Dudy mill land
in Bladen County

2nd Item I will and devise to my Sister
Louisa Rollins Seventy five acres of Land
off of the Dudy mill land adjoining P. P. Rollins

3rd Item I will and devise to my sister
Mahala Rollins Seventy five acres of Land
off of the Dudy land adjoining Louisa Rollins
and her own land and also Thirteen acres
of land lying on the South side and joining
her land. Known as the Joseph land.

4th Item I will and devise all of my land
in Cumberland County known as the Page land
and the Sullivan land to my two Sisters
Malinda Atkinson and Ann Martin to be
equally divided between them.

5th Item I will and devise that all the residue
of my property be sold and all money

arising from the sale of property or that
may be due me in any way. after paying
my just debts be distributed in the
following manner.

1st Item I will and devise to my two cousins
Harriett Matilda Thagard and Eliza Lucinda
Thagard Twenty five Dollars each.

2^d Item I will and devise that all the resi-
-due of my estate be equally divided
between my two Sisters Lavinia Rollins and
Mahala Rollins and my Niece Marcia Martin.
Lastly I appoint my trusty friend Peyton P.
Rollins as my sole Executor to execute his
my last will and testament to all intents
and purposes.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal revoking and declaring null
and void all former wills by me heretofore
made.
