I James Revels being sick and weak but of sound mind and memory and knowing that it was appointed for all men once to die do make and publish this my last will and testament to fix and settle my temporal affairs wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with before my death in the following manner to wit

first I order all my Just debts to be Paid out of my Estate

second I order my wife ~~Genl~~ Revels have her freedom and I intrust my worthy friends Malcom Monroe and Archd Buchanan Esqrs to make application to the legislature of North Carolina for her Emancipation and to see that sufficient security to Endemnify the State and county be tendered and I order that all my Estate be for her support and if any of my estate that is to say all my lands Stock of all kind household and Kitchen furniture should remain at my wifes death it shall be at her disposal I direct my Executors to sell to the best advantage ~~and the money~~ my young Mare and the money to be applied to the use of my wife

I publish this my last will and testament and I nominate make and ordain my worthy friends Malcom Monroe and Archd Buchanan Esqrs Executors to this my last will and testament and in Presence of Robert Monroe & Patrick Monroe being Present at the time of signing and sealing thereof Witness my hand and seal this 26th day of December A.D. 1841
