 Cumberland County } St. John Marrick senr, of the
 County & State aforesaid, being of sound and
 Perfect mind and memory (Blessed be god) do,
 this 24th day of July in the year of our Lord 1833,
 Make and publish this my Last will and
 Testaments in manner following; that is to say,
 First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mar-
 tha Marrick the Place whereon I now reside containing
 150 acres of Land during her life time or widowhood
 then to be divided equally between my two youngest
 Daughters. Mary Ann & Catharine also ~~the~~ of
 241 acres called the Hobbs Place for ten years then
 to be equally divided between my four oldest
 Daughters Abby, Betsey, Susanah & Anna Jane;
 also I give & bequeath unto to my wife my negro
 Boy named Bob her life time or widowhood
 then to belong to the child which my wife Martha is
 now with child with if it should be born alive,
 and live if ~~not~~ ^{the child} to be divided between my two
 youngest daughter Mary Ann, & Catharine, also
 fifty acres more or less ~~to~~ being all that is on
 this side of the creek now called Cedar Creek to
 my wife Martha during her life time or widowhood
 then to be equally divided between my two youngest
 Daughters Mary Ann, & Catharine also I give &
 Bequeath unto my wife Martha all my house hold
 and kitchen Furniture of every description and all
 stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs and sheep working
 and farming tools of all kinds during her life
 time or widowhood only that there be as much
 of the last named Property that shall be of least use

To my wife as well pay all my just debts and
and raise fifty dollars in Cash for my eldest
Bryant Warrick ~~after~~ his death a widow to be with
and equally divided amongst all my children that
shall then be alive also I give unto my son
John Warrick ~~unto~~ all my Land on the East
side of Cedar Creek to the sum of said Creek supposed
to be 400 acres more or less -

And I hereby make and ordain my wife
Martha Warrick Executrix of this my last will
and Testament In witness whereof I the said
John Warrick have to this my last will and Testament
set my hand and seal this day and above
written -
