Josiah Williams being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul to the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the Direction of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and of touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form

First I make and appoint my beloved Daughter Jane Williamson sole heir of all my lands Messuages and all movebels whatsoever by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed

Also I give and bequeath out of Estate unto Catherine Fields my honest and faithful Servant and housekeeper Thirty pounds one shilling and all my hogs her bed and all the bedcloze together with all the household furniture fitting for housekeeping

Also I do constitute make and ordain the following my Executors as folowth. viz Thomas Mattheos Daniel M Neal John Cameron Ralph Davis and John Kenney, and I do hereby utterly Discontinue and Disanule all and Every other former Testaments Wills legacies and bequests and Executions by me any ways before made or named willed or bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this to be my last will and Testament and no other in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day and Year above Written

Signed sealed published pronounced and Declared by the said Josiah Williamson as his last will and Testament in the presence of us the subscribers

Be it known to all men by these presents that I
Josiah Williamson of Mayfield planter have made and
Declared my last will and Testament in writing bearing date

Jane Williamson or none of her ^{in a non for myt clear the said State} Heires (omⁿ to Inherit the
Estate it is to Sale to the aforesaid John and Charles it lies
well and meaning is that this Codicil or Shewbule be adjud-
ged to be a part of my last will and Testament and that
all things therein Mentioned and Contained be faithfully and
truly performed and as fully and amply in Every respect
as if the same were so Declared and Set Down in my last
Will Testament. Witness my hand this
