90 In the name of God, Amen. This the twenty
fifth day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty.
I Mark Phillips of Cumberland County
and State of North Carolina and in the
town of Fayetteville, being in a low state
of health but of sound mind and memory
do make this my last will and testament
at the same time utterly revoking all for-
mer wills made by me declaring this to
be my last will and testament.

First, I Give and bequeath to my Daughter
Nancy Barnhill two pound ten Shillings —
to my Daughter Dorcas Barnhill two pound
ten Shillings, and lastly after all my just
debts are paid. I Give and bequeath to my
wife Mary Phillips my negro man Jacob
and all the rest and residue, of my Estates
whether real or personal and all my Stock
in Trade and every thing I am possessed of
whatsoever or wheresoever to my wife
Mary Phillips to dispose of at her will
and Pleasure, this my last will and

— testament, to which I have hereunto set
my hand and seal. This the 25th day
of January in the year of our Lord
