pay over to the said Rosy Hanes as soon  
as my desire or to have one Hundred ~~Dollars~~  
Dollars of the proceeds of Negro Jim

Mar 9<sup>th</sup> I further give to Nancy after my death  
one half of the potato crop now on the

Item My will and desire is that all the residue of my  
estate of any after taking out the debts and legacies  
above mentioned shall be sold and the debts owing  
to me now called and if there should be any  
surplus over and above the payment of my debts  
~~at expenses~~ and legacies that such surplus shall  
be equally divided and paid over to my Legatees  
being in equal proportion three & their children  
three and each and every of them their executors  
administrators and assigns absolutely forever

And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint  
my trusty Friend Alfred Jackson my lawful executor
