I Peter J. Perry, of the town of Fayetteville State of North Carolina being in good health, and of sound & disposing mind and Memory, and being desirous to settle my worldly Affairs whilst I have strength and capacity to do so, Do make and Publish this my last will and testament, hereby Revoking and making void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made.

 Absolutely.

Item. Should my wife Jane Perry die
 before me, In that case my will is, and I give
 and bequeath all my Real and personal property
 as afore said, To Messrs John Huske, John W. Wright
 and Charles P. Mattett, Executors and Administrators for ever, upon and subject
 to the following uses and trusts, that is to say to the
 use of Maria Sophia Perry wife of John Francis
 now living in St. Julien Near Bergenac Depassee
 of the Dordogne, in France. To her, Her heirs and
 Assigns for ever, Nevertheless on the conditions that
 they become Naturalized Subjects of the United States
 at the time this will take effect, that my Death, or
 some convenient time after.

Item. Should the said Maria Sophia Perry
~~not~~ become a Citizen of the United States at
 my Death. Then it is my will and Desire, that
 my said trustees shall and dispose of all my Estate
 both real and Personal, and the Monies arising
 therefrom to go to the use of my wife's Sister
 Maria Sophia Perry, as heretofore named her
 Executors and Administrators for ever.

And, I hereby Nominate and Appoint
 Messrs John Huske, John W. Wright and Charles
 P. Mattett, My Executors to carry into
 effect this my last will and Testament.
