1 Jacob Rodgers of the County of Cumberland
planter being very sick and weak in body but of
perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto god
calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to dye do make
and ordain this my last will and testament. That is to
say principally and first of all I give and commend my
soul into the hand of almighty god that gave it and my
body I commend to the Earth to be buried in decent
Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall
receive the same again. By the mighty power of god and
as lacking such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased
god to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same
in the following Manner and form

First I give to my beloved wife Ruth the plantation
wherem I now live During her Natural life and
Likewise I give and bequeath to My to Ruth My dearly
beloved wife one Bay pacing Mare Banded with two
hooks all the hoggs to Me belonging and one feather
Bed and furniture

Also I give to my Well beloved Daughter Elizabeth
Hancock one cow and calf running at her own house
and that to her full part of my Estate

Also I give to my beloved Daughter Sarah Rodgers one
feather Bed and furniture and one cow and calf one young
Bay Mare Banded with a cross and that to be her full
part of My Estate. Also I give to My Well beloved daugh-
ter Maryann Rodgers one feather Bed and furniture
one cow and calf one Bright Bay Mare with a star in
her forehead Banded with a sword shurup & horn
Also I give to My sons John and Enock Rodgers My
land and tennament to be divided as follows Beginning
at a white oak at the lower end of the old field known by
the name of the Royal oak the upper end to John the
lower end to Enock and to run from the above mentioned
oak a direct line to the line. Also I leave to My
Well Beloved wife all the rest of my Movable Estat
and stock of all kinds working tools and other conveniences
for the use of paying My just Debts and Raising and schooling
My children and at her Death all such Estate to be
Equally divided between My two sons John and Enock

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I Likewise constitute Make and ordain My Dearly
Beloved wife Ruth and my Dearly friend James Muff
My sole Executrix and Executor of this my last will and
testament and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoke and
disannul all and Every other former Testaments Wills
Legacies bequests and Executors by Me in any ways before named
written and bequeathed Ratified Ratifying ~~and~~ and
confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament
in all things wherof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
Nineteenth day of June one thousand seven hundred and
seventy four

and declared by the sd Jacob Rodgers
as his last Will and testament in

Then were the Execution of this Will in Open Court
in due form of law proved by the Oath of Charles Sheering
One of the Subscribing Witnesses thereto & Ordered to be
Recorded And at same time Ruth Rodgers Executrix and
James Muff Executor of said Will qualified by taking
the Oath her law appoints for Executors Ordered That they

Witnessed and signed 7
