Being of sound and perfect mind and memory
Blessed be God do this 12th day of February
in the year of our Lord 1858 make and publish
this my last will and testament in manner
following, that is to say —
1st I Recommend My soul to allmighty God, and
my body to the dust and my worldly estate as
follows. — 2nd I give and bequeth to my grand-
son William Brane one hundred acres of land
and one third of my cattle, and one half of my
hogs, and all my farming utensils —
3rd I give and bequeth to the heirs of Timothy
Carrington My son in law, and Catharine his wife
fifty acres of land and two thirds of my cattle
4th I give and bequeth to my granddaughter Mary
Campbell all the right and title that I have
to a mare or any of her increase that was bought
with my money, also to said Mary Campbell
I give all my bed clothes and the half not given
to William Brane, of my hogs, and one pot
5th I give and bequeth to My son in law Arch. D. Smith
and his heirs by Effy his wife one dollar —
6th I Also leave two four year old steers or their value
in money to defray the Charges of my
funeral —
