Lute provisions as may be on hand, My Gig Wagon
ploughs with the Harness &c. &c. —

Item 2^d I give and Bequeath to my Grand Son John
Beard the sum of One Dollar —

Item 3^d I give and Bequeath to my ~~Daughter~~ Grand
Daughter Sophia Beard after the Death of my dear
Wife One third of all my Negroes, Slaves as many there
be a line to stand as are now living or may be born in
the life time of my Wife except the sum of Five Hundred
to be deducted from the One third in valuation to said
Negroes for a Negro given to her Mother herebefore —

It is my will and desire that should the said Soph-
-iah Beard Die without leaving Issue from her Body that
said Negroes Return to James & Henkin Plummer or
their Heirs —

Item 4th I give & Bequeath to my Sons James & Henkin
Plummer all of my personal property not given to my
dear Wife also after the Death of my dear Wife It is
my will and desire that the tract of Lands I now live
on or may or do now own shall be equally divided between
the said James & Henkin or their Heirs as also all
Lute personal property as may be on hand that I have
given my dear Wife during her life time at her Death shall
be equally divided between the said James & Henkin or
their Heirs except the one third of the Negroes given Sophia Beard
