Item 3rd I nominate constitute and appoint
my friend Henry Selby & my wife
Mary Elizabeth Executor & Executrix
to this my Last Will & Testament
themselves revoking and annulling

be set free. my will is that she and
they and all of them be by my Executor
sent on carriage to a free State, and that
they defray all necessary expenses out of
my Estate. London 11th Sept 1847.
