Item I give to my Daughter Mary Sarves One negroe girl that is named Rachel which is now in her possession Also two cows & calves like even in her possession to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give to my Daughter Ann Sanderson One Negroe girl named Dice to her & her heirs, Also one bed & furniture, & three cows & calves to her & her heirs.

Item I give to my Daughter Lyda before mentioned one Negroe girl named Callahan to her & her heirs but also reserving the use of said Negroe girl to the use of my wife Ann untill my said Daughter may come to age or shall get married.

Item I give to my Daughter Julian Sanderson One Negroe girl called Chanah to her & her heirs, but I do hereby reserve the use of said Negroe girl to my wife Anne Sanderson untill my said Daughter Julian shall come to age or is married.

Item I give unto my son John Sanderson one Black Walnut Desk to him & his heirs.

Item I will & desire that one Negroe girl called Delily & also one Iron bound Cart be sold at six months credit to discharge any debts - which may arise at the same time not requiring the Negroe to be sold should there be a possibility of doing without In that case I bequeath the said Negroe Delily to my Daughter Ann Sanderson & her heirs.

Item I give & bequeath One little Negroe boy named Dick to my Daughter Lyda & her heirs but also reserving the use of said Negroe to my wife Ann untill my said Daughter Lyda come to age or is married.

Item I give & bequeath unto my wife Ann Sanderson all the residue of my Estate that is not hereby or already given away, within four or without for the support of my four children namely Ann, John, Julian, & Lyda, and should my said wife die before all of which is bequeathed then to be equally divided amongst the said four children before mentioned.

Lastly I do hereby bequeath & appoint all my wife Anne Sanderson, Sanderson & Thomas Beach my whole sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament utterly & fully & legally disannulling all other Wills In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this year & day last mentioned & written.

In the name of God Amen, January 9th 1785, I Abel Carter of the County of North Carolina being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks to God do make constitute & ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say I do recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it to me desiring his most gracious Acceptance of it nothing doubting but at the Resurrection I shall receive the same again & my body I recommend that it to be buried in a Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors & as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I do give & dispose of in the following manner & I do hereby give & bequeath to my well beloved son Henry like my land.

Item I give & bequeath to me three sons Henry like & Benjamin like & John like all the rest of Estate to be equally divided amongst them at the discretion of my well beloved wife Charity like not disturbing nor molesting her in her lifetime excepting one Cow & Lamb I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Bullitt, One Cow & Lamb & I leave my wife Charity like & my son Henry like Executors to this my last Will & Testament disallowing any other Wills I do hereby disannulling & Testifying this to be my last Will & Testament.
