 Recorded when Letter of administration  
 with the will annexed was granted to  
 Trunagan Taylor who Qualifies and bonds  
 in due form of Law.  
 Recorded May 13<sup>th</sup> 1830 S. Ashlee

The Last will and Testament of Abraham  
 Waterfield decd. was exhibited and proved  
 at February Term 1830.  
 In the name of God Amen I Abraham  
 Waterfield of the County of Currituck  
 & State of North Carolina Planter being  
 sick but of perfect mind calling to mind  
 the mortality of man & knowing it is once  
 appointed to man to die I having  
 minded to dispose of all my worldly goods  
 in manner & form as follows.  
 Item I give and bequeath unto my son Zach-  
 ariah Waterfield the plantation whereon  
 I now live together with all the land on  
 the Indian Creek and round and  
 two Sugar cane & one Cider Tree one  
 yoke of Oxen I have one young heifer one  
 small cow one fat & fat spot two Kitties  
 and one grubbing hoe and one hand  
 saw to him and his heirs forever.  
 Item I give unto my son Sanders  
 Waterfield one mare named Beauty  
 one canoe by the name Fair play also one  
 Kitties & one grubbing hoe one fat spot  
 one bed and furniture just to have  
 to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter  
 Sally one bed & furniture second choice &  
 one Dollar to her & her heirs forever.  
 Item I give and bequeath unto my son  
 Jolly & Mattfield one Dollar to him and  
 his heirs forever.  
 Item I give and bequeath unto my son  
 Zachariah Waterfield one bed & furniture  
 and all the plank I have got to repair  
 the house to him and his heirs forever  
 also one hand mill and two Cabbages.  
 Item I give and bequeath unto my sons  
 Zachariah & Sanders Waterfield five Bar-  
 nels of corn to be equally divided between  
 them.  
 Item I give unto my daughter  
 Julia Spratt one large wheel to her  
 heirs forever.  
 Item I give the balance of my estate  
 to be sold by my Executor & after pay-  
 ing all my debts the balance to be  
 divided between the following children  
 & my wife living namely Sarah Ward Leahy  
 Carbons to children Lydia Beasley Julia  
 Spratt Rosay Dudley to them and their  
 heirs forever.  
 I nominate constitute & appoint my  
 friends Jno B. Jones my heir and should  
 Executor to this my last will and testam-  
 ent Revoking all others by my name  
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set  
 my hand and caused my seal to  
 be fixed this 7<sup>th</sup> day of December 1829
